## WHAT DO WE DO?

There comes a time when we may need to move on to a safe space to live as we grow older. We can help you find the best option for you.

We can support you through the process and offer guidance when looking at Care Homes, Assisted Living, and Independent Living Accommodation.

We will safely transport you and/or a family member to view up to 3 different venues of choice in our wheelchair-accessible vehicle/taxi.

We will liaise with health professionals to ensure a joined-up service, providing the best support.

We will seek feedback from you 91 days after using our service, to ensure we are offering the right service.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The service is available to anyone over the age of 65 living in Sheffield. People below this age may be referred for consideration.

## WHERE DO REFERRALS COME FROM?

We take referrals from a wide range of sources including social work teams, intermediate care teams, care coordinators, and community health professionals. We also take self and family referrals.

## HOW MUCH DOES THE SERVICE COST?

We do not charge for our services.
